## AMENDMENTS AND REFERENDUMS 2014

The Libertarian Party of Illinois has issued its official recommendations regarding the Amendments and Referendums on the November 4<sup>th</sup> ballot. Many issues here are being made subject to popular opinion, and so we recommend the following based on our guiding principles of individual liberty for all.

### Crime Victims' Rights Amendment

The proposed amendment would expand certain rights already granted to crime victims in Illinois, and give crime victims the ability to enforce their rights in a court of law. You are asked to decide whether the proposed amendment should become part of the Illinois Constitution. **We recommend: vote Yes**

### Right to Vote Amendment

The proposed amendment adds a new section to the Suffrage and Elections Article of the Illinois Constitution. The proposed amendment would prohibit any law that disproportionately affects the rights of eligible Illinois citizens to register to vote or cast a ballot based on the voter's race, color, ethnicity, status as a member of a language minority, national origin, religion, sex, sexual orientation, or income. You are asked to decide whether the proposed amendment should become part of the Illinois Constitution. **We recommend: vote Yes**

### Minimum Wage Increase (Nonbinding referendum)

Shall the minimum wage in Illinois for adults over the age of 18 be raised to \$10 per hour by January 1, 2015?  
**We recommend: vote No**

### Prescription Birth Control in Drug Coverage (Nonbinding referendum)

Shall any health insurance plan in Illinois that provides prescription drug coverage be required to include prescription birth control as part of that coverage? (Nonbinding referendum) **We recommend: vote No**

### Millionaire Tax Increase to help Schools (Nonbinding referendum)

Additional revenue for school districts from an additional 3% tax over greater than one million dollars  
Should the Illinois Constitution be amended to require that each school district receive additional revenue, based on their number of students, from an additional 3% tax on income greater than one million dollars?  
**We recommend: vote No**
