Two state-wide Libertarian candidates running in the 2014 General Election have confirmed their presence at a candidate forum this Thursday evening at Southeastern Illinois College. They are Sharon Hansen for US Senate and Ben Koyl for Illinois Attorney General.

Most of those running at the state level will follow conventional thinking and stick to more densely-populated metropolitan areas for this final stretch of the campaign season, but our candidates have been especially well received by Southern Illinoisans, many who express feelings of disillusionment with the largely corrupt northern establishment. The Libertarians, therefore, are returning south to visit the small community on the Shawnee's edge, Harrisburg.

Ben is a bankruptcy lawyer who vows to expose and fight the corruption, fraud and government waste that costs tax-payers. Sharon, on the other hand, is a 63 year-old grandmother who has lost all faith in the other major political parties, and embraces what she considers to be many common-sense libertarian solutions.

Candidates from all over the area have been invited, so we hope that you will attend and help to inform Southern Illinois' voters about all their options on the upcoming November ballot.
